

MORNING DROP OFF

Now that the children have been at school for over a month can we please ask parents/carers to start to drop children off at the school gate in the morning and allow them to make their own way around to class. This will help reduce the volume of people within the grounds.

Mrs Law & Mrs Campbell will be outside the infant area from 8.45am and Mrs Hughes or Mr Scobbie will be at the school gate to see the children in safely.

Parents/Carers can still collect children from the classroom doors at 3pm to reduce the volume of people gathering at the gate.

FUNDING AWARD

We are delighted to announce that we have received funding from the Coalburn, Douglas and Glespin Community Fund to continue work on the grounds at the back of the school. The works will provide drainage to create an orchard area and provide safe access to the pond area.

We have also received funding from SLC Renewable Energy Fund for a feasibility study of our woodland area to take place. The study will aim to further develop the area to support Forest Schools and sustainability.





PARENT COUNCIL

Our Parent Council are always keen to welcome new parents from both the school and ELC.

The group meet approximately 5 times throughout the year and support Mrs Hughes in the school and ELC's improvement journey and in organising a range of events for the children throughout the year.

ELECTRIC SCOOTERS

We have noted a significant increase in the number of children who are coming to school on an electric scooter. Can you please remind your child that all electric scooters should be turned off at the first entrance gate and walked down into the school playground and the same on the way out, they must not be ridden until your child has left the school grounds.

We also had a few incidents of children returning to the school grounds after 3pm to ride around the MUGA pitch or in the car park, this is not allowed and any further incidents will be reported to the police.

HOMEWORK

Homework will commence on the week beginning the 22nd September. Google Classroom is the platform that we use to share our weekly homework tasks and it also gives you an additional place to contact your child's teacher. A letter will be sent home with your child that will give you instructions on how to log into your child's Google Classroom.

We issue homework in order to consolidate learning that is taking place in the classroom and to allow parents to engage with their child's learning. Within the infant stages reinforcement of phonics and reading is vital in supporting your child to become literate. We would therefore ask that you all engage with the Google Classroom platform.

Those children in middle and upper stages should be able to access Google Classroom independently and homework tasks are set at a level that should allow your child to complete them independently if required.

Homework remains a key focus at high school, therefore it is important that at primary school we are supporting our children to become independent in organising their time in order to complete homework tasks issued.

If you are not able to access Google Classroom then please contact the school office or speak to your child's teacher and a paper copy of your child's homework tasks can be provided for you.
